

Automotive Trades Association and RGDA 2019 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Automotive Trades Association of Atlantic Canada will award an Annual Scholarship valued at up to \$2,000.00. The scholarship will be awarded to **any son or daughter** of a member of the Automotive Trades Association in good standing. Automotive Trades Association membership includes Auto Dealerships, Retail Gasoline Dealers, Collision Repairers, Tire Dealers and many independent service and repair shops.

Scholarship Award Guidelines

1. To be considered for a scholarship, the member must be the business owner and/or operator and submit an official application, in writing, to the A.T.A. Scholarship Committee, postmarked no later than **September 1, 2019**.
2. Applicants who plan to attend any recognized educational and/or trades training institution approved by the A.T.A. Scholarship Committee will be eligible.
3. The scholarship maximum is **\$500.00** per year and has a 4-year limit. The cheque will be made out to both the student and to the institution of his/her choice. To qualify for each of the four annual payments of \$500.00, students will be required to provide proof of admission to an approved institution for each of the four years.
4. The method of disbursement of the \$500.00 annual award will be determined at the sole discretion of the A.T.A. Scholarship Committee.
5. The A.T.A. Scholarship Committee reserves the right to make such other rules and regulations, as it deems necessary, in order to effectively administer the scholarship fund. Decisions of the A.T.A. Scholarship Committee will be final.
6. The A.T.A. retains the right to publish a photograph and information on the winner in its newsletter.
7. Recipients of the scholarship must apply each year to the A.T.A. Scholarship Committee, in writing, for a renewal, and include an official transcript of their grades for that academic year. 8. The A.T.A. reserves the right to abandon or modify the scholarship program, in the event of circumstances, the nature of which would render the continuance of the program impractical.
